

APPLICATION FOR AWPA TECHNICAL OR SPECIAL COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP

IMPORTANT: Technical and Special Committee membership applications are usually considered at each Executive Committee meeting and should be received at least 30 days prior to the meeting to be considered. Special Committee applications may be submitted at any time. Technical Committee applications may be submitted after a person has been an AWPA member in good standing for at least 365 calendar days, or after they have attended one full meeting of the committee to which they are applying for. **Applicants will be notified of their status after Executive Committee action and the committee membership database has been updated. This process may take up to six months before you are notified of the status of your application.** Only one person from any entity may serve on a single Technical Committee. Applications which would cause there to be two persons from a single organization to become members of a Technical Committee will be rejected. - Producer Member: Those whose primary interest in AWPA affairs parallels that of those who are engaged in the production, sale, promotion or distribution of wood protection systems, treated wood, or components thereof.
- User Member: Those whose primary interest in AWPA affairs parallels that of those who are engaged in the use of, the specification of, or the inspection of treated wood products, or whose primary interest in the use of treated material is for the retail sales of consumer products or the fabrication of products made from treated materials.
- General Interest Member: Those whose primary interests would not be expected to necessarily parallel the interests of either "Producer Members" or "User Members".

I hereby attest that I have read and understand the AWPA Technical Committee Regulations and that I will participate in Technical Committee activities by attending meetings, voting on Technical Committee and General ballots, contributing to the work of Task Groups, and by answering correspondence.
